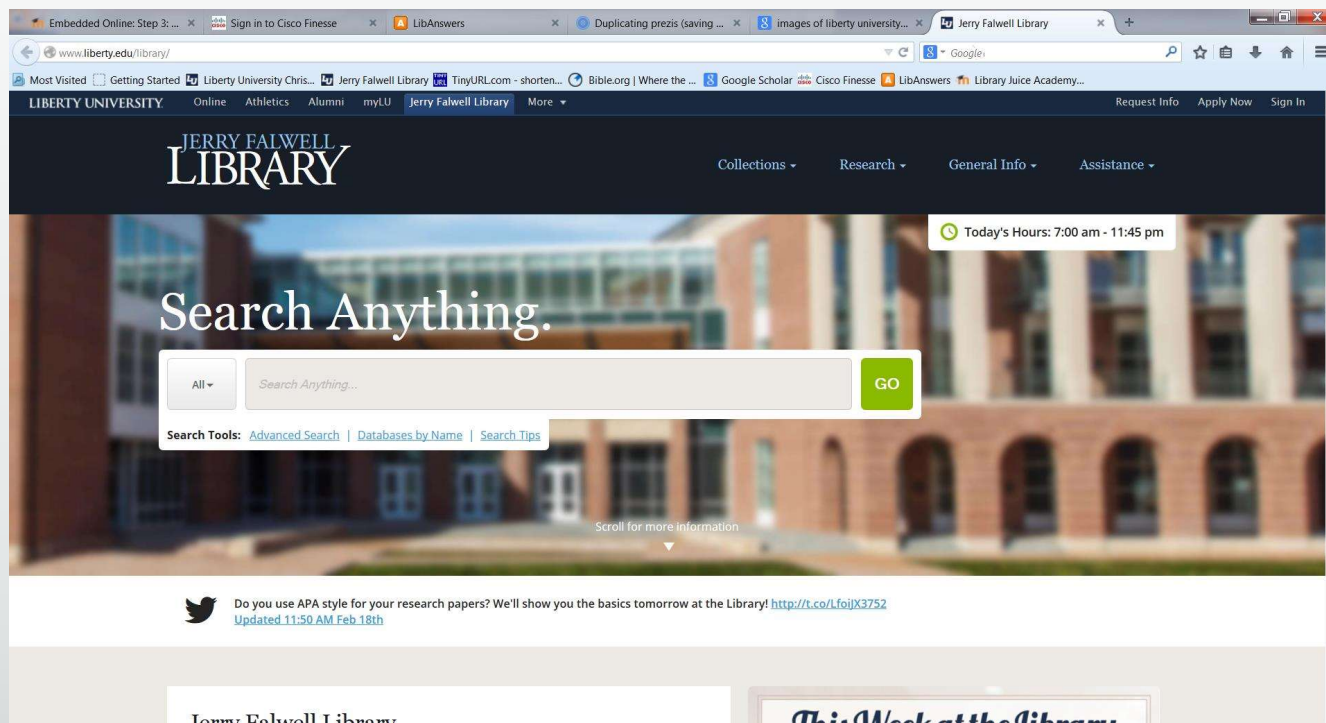
Students should not just memorize facts from information learned in college but how to apply the information learned to solve problems, especially in their subject/career area.



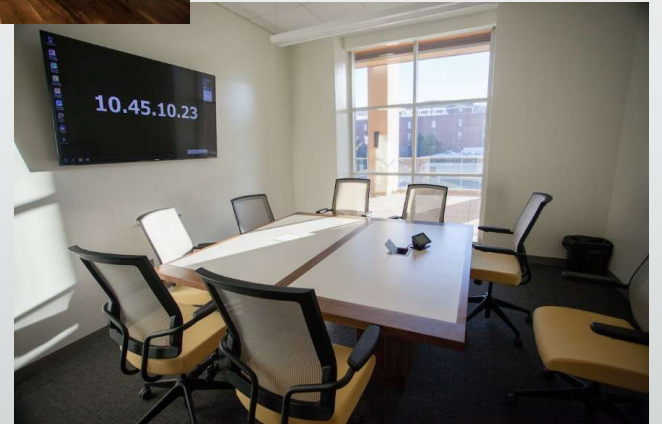
How can librarians work with professors to help our students succeed in school, life and their careers?




How can students become more familiar with their subject area? Lectures, textbooks, and research...
