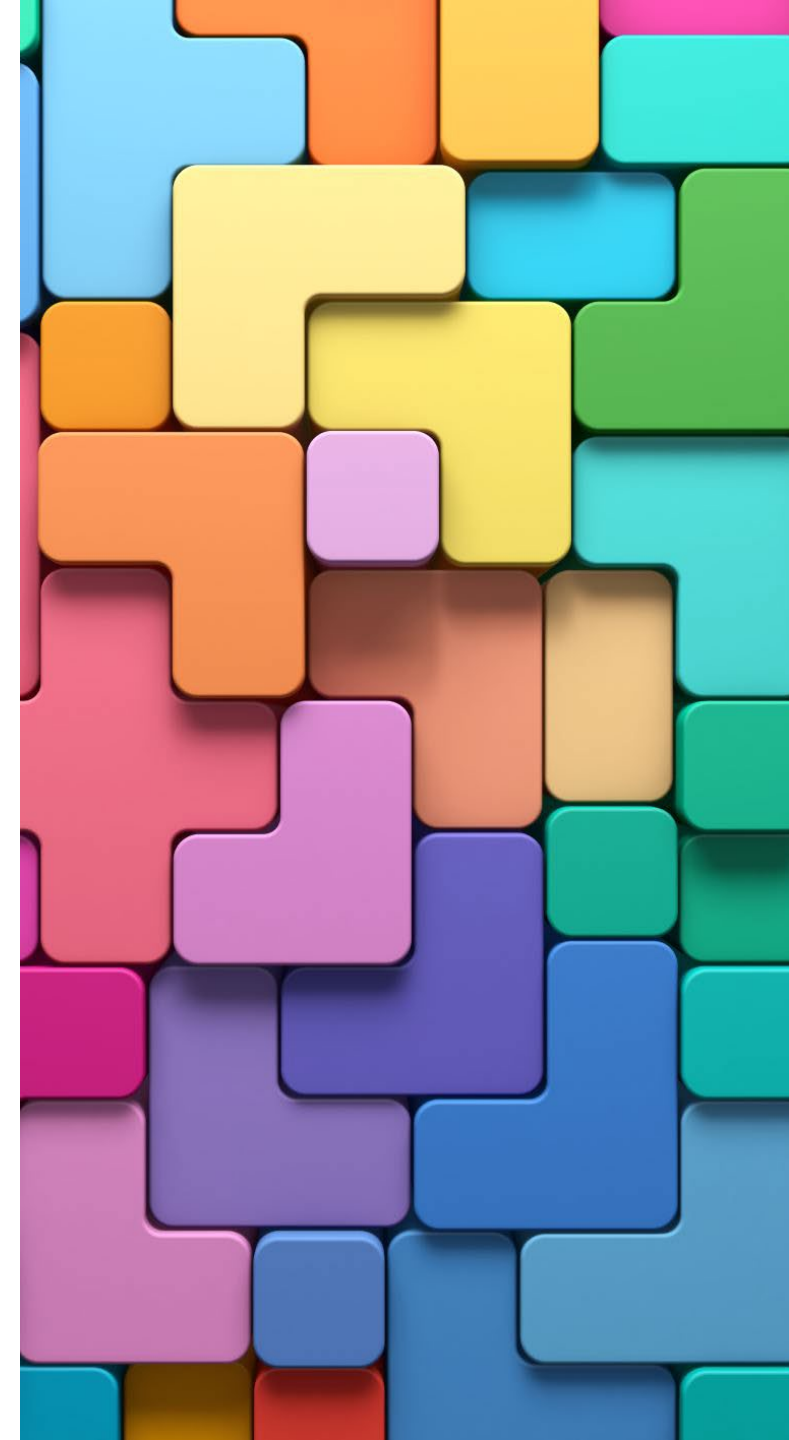

# What is OER?

“teaching, learning, and research materials in any medium, digital or otherwise, that reside in the public domain or have been released under an open license that permits no-cost access, use, adaptation, and redistribution by others with no or limited restrictions”  
(2012 Paris OER Declaration)



# What can I do with OER?

- **Retain:** Make, own, and control copies of the content
- **Reuse:** Use the content in a variety of ways
- **Revise:** Adapt, adjust, modify, improve, or alter the content
- **Remix:** Combine the original or revised content with other OER to create something new
- **Redistribute:** Share copies of the original content, your revisions, or your remixes with others

# How can I share my OER?

## Creative Commons and Copyright

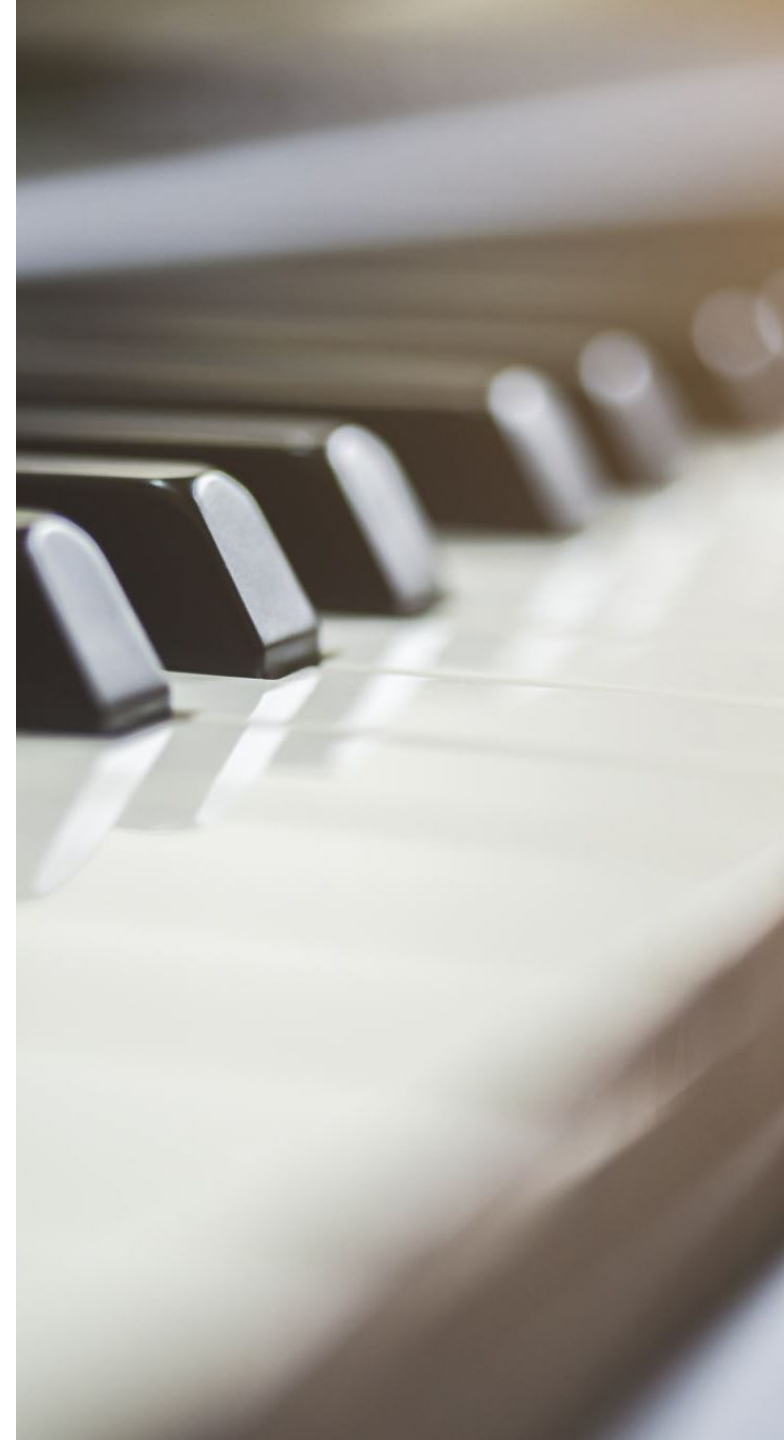
- **Attribution:** list the author
- **Derivatives:** transform someone else's work
- **Commercial:** sell the work
- **Share Alike:** share copies of the content with the same license
