	9	Was rejected by his own people—Acts 25:2, 3
	10	Dearly loved his own people—Rom. 9:1-3; 10:1
	11	Often plotted against—Acts 23:12-14
	12	Knew he would die a violent death—2 Tim. 4:6
	13	Forgave his enemies shortly before he died—2 Tim. 4:16
	14	Anticipated a crown from his Father. This was a martyr's crown of righteousness—2 Tim. 4:8

	2	Was sent that there might be a gospel to be preached—Matt. 1:21; 1 Cor. 15:3, 4
	3	Gave instructions to Paul on the road to Damascus—Acts 9:10
	4	Changed him to become a faithful sheep dog, shepherding the sheep—Acts 9:15
	5	Wrought many miracles—John 3:2; 20:30
	6	Acquainted with hardships—Matt. 8:20
	7	Experienced severe satanic oppression—Matt. 4:1-11; Mark 14:32-34
	8	Accused of blasphemy—Matt. 26:64, 65
	9	Was rejected by His own people—John 1:10, 11
	10	Dearly loved His own people—Matt. 23:37-39; Luke 19:41
	11	Often plotted against—John 11:47, 53
	12	Knew He would die a violent death—Matt. 20:17-19
	13	Forgave His enemies shortly before He died—Luke 23:34
	14	Anticipated a crown from His Father. This will be a monarch's ruling crown—Rev. 11:15
	15	Finished His God-given assignment—John 17:4
