Foid, femoid	degragatory terms for women
Sh*tposting	making progressively outrageous statements to solicit a reaction
Blackpilled	acceptance that that there is no hope of ever being accepted by society or having successful relationships with women

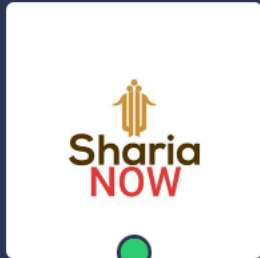
- Social hierarchy dominated by abusive women
